Shaughnessy, Bridget, nee Hartnett, Sept. 24, 1893, at 4012 Wright st., wife of John, native of Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick, aged 47 yrs. Funeral from St. Gabriel's Church to Sag Bridge. (1)

Walsh, John, at Summit, IL, Dec. 17, 1897, husband of Margaret Sullivan, father of James, John, Patrick Walsh, Mrs. Johannah Johnstone, Mrs. Mary Murphy, Mrs. Margaret Welbourne, and Ellen Walsh, aged 79 yrs., 6 mos., native of Co. Tipperary. Burial Sag Bridge. (1)

Foran, Patrick 1850-1922; Margaret, wife of Patrick, native of Clonea, Parish of Mothil (sic), Co. Waterford 1850-1900 (5) Margaret Foran, nee Cahill, mother of Mary, Michael and Nellie, born in Parish Clonea, Co. Waterford, aged 48 yrs. Funeral to Sag Bridge -Sept. 3, 1900 (1)

Guilfoyle, Ann, June 7, 1891, wife of John, aged 70 yrs., born in Co. Westmeath. Funeral from resid., of her daughter, Mrs. Dunphy, 735 W. 14th st. to St. Boniface Church, corner of Silver and 12th, thence to Sag Bridge cemetery

Hayes, Jeremiah J., died Feb. 23, 1899, of Killaloe, Co. Clare, aged 34 yrs., was one of twelve children, ten of whom survive, nine sisters and a brother, Katie, Sarah, Johanna, Julia, Lizzie, and Mrs. Cornelius Hayes. Three of the sisters entered religious life as Sisters of Mercy: Sr. Mary Lewis, Sr. Benedict, and Sr. Agnes, and the late Sr. Gonzaga; and his brother- John, still lives in the old homestead. Funeral from his sister's resid., 5518 S. Halsted st. to Sag Bridge -March 4, 1899 (2) (1)

McMullen, William, Nov. 1, 1892, husband of Julia, nee Cahill, aged 66 yrs., 4 mos., native of Co. Antrim. Funeral from resid., 2712 Union to Sag bridge. (1)

Ryan, Patrick H., of 452 Austin ave., husband of Ellen, nee McLaughlin, native of Twomileborris, Co. Tipperary, will be removed from the vault at Calvary and interred at **Sag Bridge** on April 30, 1891

Byrnes, John, Sept. 30, 1893, aged 33 yrs., husband of Bridget nee Gaffney, and brother of James and Bridget Byrnes, a native of Parish St. Mullins, Co. Carlow. Funeral from resid., 37 Grace st. to Immaculate Conception Church **to Sag Bridge** cemetery (1)

Kimmev, John Husband of Annie (nee Killeen), father of Helen, Joseph and Catherine, Mrs. Mary Hill, Mrs. Elizabeth Hill, Mrs. Annie Joyce, Mrs. Della Kerber, Mrs. Margaret Mousel, and the late James, John and Edward Kimmev; parish of Kiltormer, native of Bellview, Co. Galway. Funeral from his later residence, 598 Laflin st. to St. Pius Church thence to **Sag Bridge** cemetery. --March 11, 1905 (1)

Reidy, Mary At 601 43rd st., wife of Michael, mother of Dan and Jennie and Mrs. Henry P. Turner, aged 51 yrs., native of Ballyheige, Co. Kerry. Funeral from St. Gabriel's church to **Sag Bridge**. --Feb. 27, 1904 (1)
